

2010 Annual Meeting Information Sheet

CPMC Annual Meeting will be held in
Mountain Lake, Minnesota
June 24-27, 2010

Registration will take place at First Mennonite Church on Thursday, June 24, beginning at 5:00 pm. The youth groups from Bethel & First Mennonite Churches will be providing an **evening meal** from 5:00 pm – 6:30 pm for anyone wishing to attend. This meal is offered for a donation to be made when you come. (This meal is NOT included in the Registration fee!)

You must register on the Registration Form, so the group can plan adequate amounts of food. An **opening program** will take place at First Mennonite Church at 7:00 pm.

Registration continues on Friday morning at Mountain Lake High School, beginning at 8:15 am. Business meetings, worship, meals, and workshops will take place at Mountain Lake High School on Friday and Saturday.

Childcare (Friday & Saturday only) will take place at Mountain Lake High School. There is no cost for childcare, but *you must register children on the child registration form*.

We will close our time together on Sunday morning, June 27, with worship at Bethel Mennonite Church at 9:30 am

Translation services for both the Spanish language and the Hmong language will be available for all group sessions. (This includes the opening program on Thursday evening, all business sessions, all worship sessions, and the closing worship service on Sunday morning.)

Please indicate on the Registration Form if you will be using the translation service and which language you will be using so we can plan for adequate head sets to be available.

Tours are tentatively planned for Thursday early afternoon and Friday late afternoon.

Heritage Village will be a guided one hour tour.

Historical Mountain Lake may be done as a guided or self-guided one hour tour.

Sign-up for these tours will be at the conference registration table when you arrive and check in.

A fee may be charged for guided tours.

None of the spaces we will be meeting in are air conditioned.
