Adult leaders help children age 4 through 8th grade select and read books from a list specifically created to reflect core Christian values of peace and justice from an Anabaptist Mennonite perspective. A child who reads seven books and “reports” on two of them will earn a free gift book of his/her choice from the list.

How do I join Shalom Readers Club?

1. Fill out the registration form and give it to the adult SRC leader in your congregation. If your church does not have a leader, send the form directly to the coordinator for your area. (See Registration Form on the next panel).

2. Read, or have someone read to you, seven (7) books **from the SRC list**, and write the titles on your record sheet. The list and record sheet are available from your church’s SRC leader, your regional coordinator (see next panel), or online at: www.centralplainsmc.org/Shalom_Readers. Books from the list may be borrowed from the CPMC library if not available locally (see address on back panel).

3. Create a book sharing about two (2) of the books you have read. You may want to work with your parents or your club leader. Here are some ideas:

- write a short description of the book, telling why you liked it, or why you didn’t
- write a song, poem, story, or skit inspired by the book and share it with someone
- create a drawing, painting, or collage that relates to the book
- do a “peace” activity inspired by the book, such as reading the book to a younger child or to an older person in your congregation/neighborhood
- discuss the book in your Sunday School class or mid-week club
- talk with an adult about how you can be more like Jesus
- write or draw about a time when you followed the Jesus way of peace in your family, with your friends, or classmates

4. When you have completed your projects on two of the books you have read and have given them to your club leader, you may choose a book from the SRC list to keep as your own! Your club leader will help you and see to it that you receive the book.

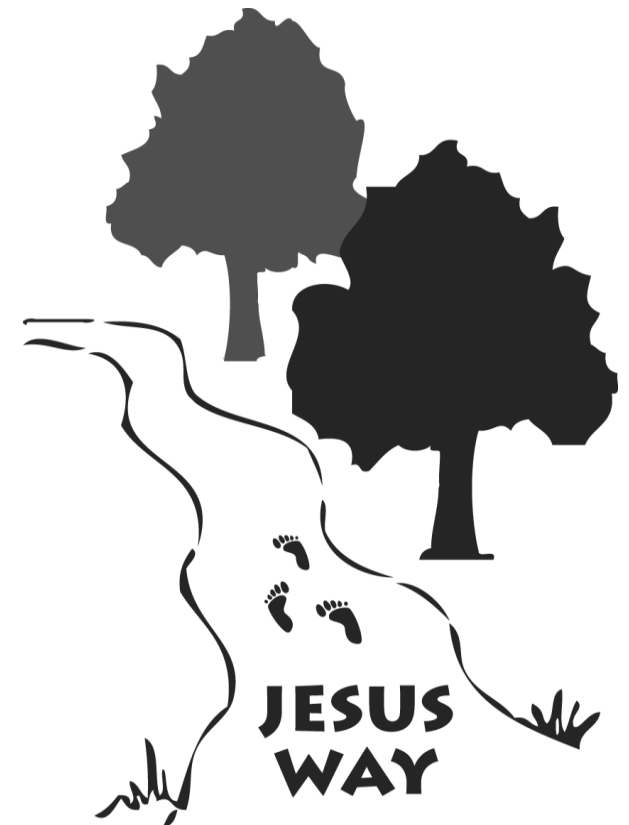
