Central Plains budget fell backwards for the second straight month in March. Income for the month was at \$27, 687.78. Expenses for the month came in at \$34,521.51, making a deficit of \$6,833.73 for the month. This result increases the overall deficit at a loss of \$23,750.70 with only

two weeks to go before our fiscal year end on April 30. We invite you to consider giving in April so we can erase this deficit and end the year in the black! Thank you. —Stewardship Task Group
